## Code of conduct for students

1. Students must attend classes, tutorials, class tests exams etc. punctually and regularly. Failure to achieve the required attendance percentage, non-submission of assignments and unjustified absence from tests/examinations will be considered violations of the Code of Conduct.
2. A student is required to sit in their classroom at the beginning of each period. They should not enter or leave the class room without the permission of the lecturer.
3. Impersonation during roll call is a punishable offence.
4. Use of mobile phones during class time is prohibited and punishable
5. Any form of malpractice (copying, impersonation, use of unfair means, exchange of answer sheets) during the examination will not be tolerated and strict action will be taken against them
6. When a lecturer is absent or unable to attend classes, students must maintain strict order among themselves so that neighboring classes are not disturbed. Under no circumstances should they leave the classroom without being ordered to relieve themselves from the staff room.
7. Students are expected to behave courteously with members of staff, both teaching and non-teaching, and with their fellow students in and outside the College. Students should not harm the reputation of the institution by their actions or behavior.
8. Students are expected to come to the college with modesty and appropriate attire.
9. Students must wear and be visible at the gate when entering the college and keep it on your person at all times during college hours on campus.
10. Students are not allowed to walk or stand in the veranda or corridors of the college during class hours.
11. Students are prohibited from inviting friends from other institutions and outsiders to the college.
12. Posters should not be pasted anywhere on the walls of the college with sellotape. Any writing on the walls will result in disciplinary action against the student.
13. Smoking, chewing and spitting of tobacco products or pan masala, consumption of alcohol or intoxicants is strictly prohibited in the college premises. Violation of this rule will result in disciplinary action. College campus is a smoke free zone, respect it.

10. Make yourself available to students beyond their classroom hours and help and guide them without compensation or reward.

11. Refrain from inciting students against colleagues or administration.
